Background information

The National University of Mongolia (NUM), a partner of the URGENT project and the coordinator of the ONE project, both funded by the ERASMUS+ program of the European Union, organized the summer school for urban resilience, adaptation, and sustainable environmental management. A summer school was jointly organized by two projects, namely Urban resilience and adaptation for India and Mongolia - URGENT and European orientation for sustainable environmental management in Mongolia – ONE projects, in Ulaanbaatar city, Mongolia between 15 and 28 July 2022. The order from the university president to organize summer school is attached. <u>Appendix 1</u>. The summer school was bringing together scholars, professionals, stakeholders, and students from the projects' partners to teach and discuss the urban environment, resilience, climate adaptation, ecosystem service-disservice, European environmental innovation, and management, including protected area management, its transferability, and applicability in Mongolia.

During summer school, the participants acquired skills and knowledge about European Union environmental innovation (including management, policy, and financial instruments) and an understanding of the urban ecology environment, green-blue infrastructure, and nature-based solutions. The summer school was organized in and out of the city and continued for 14 days. Upon successfully completing 24 participants get certificates issued by the National University of Mongolia with 4 ECTS transferred.

The objective of the summer school

The objective of the summer school was to serve as a training and knowledge exchange opportunity for domestic teaching staff, who will, together with EU colleagues, develop a detailed syllabus and teaching & learning contents, set up case studies, jointly teach, and co-supervise student research groups. The expertise exchange was in terms of EU and related topics, as also teaching and learning methods. Moreover, it was also a good way to disseminate the project's information to broaden the audience.

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






Only travel accessories and personal supplies during summer school were borne by the participants. Participants were fully responsible for their travel, health, safety issues, and insurance.

Registration and selection

The summer school was open to students at different levels (bachelor, master, Ph.D.), graduates, and lifelong learners. Online registration opened on 10 May and closed on 10 June 2022 via the online platform <u>http://registration.num.edu.mn/Home/Programs</u>.

The selection was carried out by the organizing committee based on the received documents and motivation. Finally, the



commission decided to allow all registered people to participate. The participants were informed of their acceptance on 15th June 2022 via e-mail. <u>Appendix 4</u>.





Preparation and branding

For the distinction and branding of the summer school, a horizontal stand, presentation templates in English and Mongolian, and T-shirts for staff (blue) and students (green) were prepared and used during the school.



COVID-19 prevention

During summer school, hand sanitizer, face masks, and social distancing were applied to prevent COVID spread.

Accommodation and study environment

The summer school was organized in and out of the city. In the city, study activities were held in the library building of the NUM. In the city, staff and students who came from the countryside stayed in the student hostel of the National University of Mongolia. Foreign staff stayed in the visiting professor's apartment of the university.

In the field, all participants stayed in a field camp, slept in tents, shared camp chores and maintenance, and engaged in strenuous outdoor activities such as hiking to fieldwork.



Participants

In total, 34 people registered; 27 people attended and 24 fully participated and get the certificates. Out of the registered people, 20 were university students and 14 people were lifelong learners. The gender ratio was 4 male and 30 female.

Summer school program

The program has been discussed among the organizing committee members and approved by the university. <u>Appendix 2</u> The program was also openly distributed to the public with its announcement. Summer school has organized 14 days between 15th July and 28th July 2022. It was organized in and out of the city. In the city, study activities were organized in the library building of the university. Generally, it was organized mostly outside of the classroom instead of in-class learning.

Training materials and presentations

During the summer school, 25 lectures and laboratory guidelines were given by 16 teaching staff using presentations with 725 slides. All training materials and presentations are attached, separately.





Day-to-day activity

15 July 2022 - Friday: Day 1 - In-class:

According to the summer school program, the coordinator of the school introduced the summer school and the URGENT and ONE projects. Moreover, the participants introduced themselves to the ice-breaking. After lunch, a lecture on global challenges and the state of the earth system was given by Attila Katona. And very interestingly, the SDG negotiation game is played among the participants. After all the class works, the welcome dinner was organized.



16 July 2022 – Saturday: Day 2 – In and out-class:

The lectures on the urban environment and urban megatrends were given by Ochir Altansukh and Attila Katona, respectively. Especially focused sections on soil and noise pollution were given jointly by Davaasuren Davaadorj and Bat-Erdene Ariunsanaa. After lunch, two very interesting laboratory works that strongly related to soil and noise pollution were organized and the participants were divided into 5 study groups. <u>Appendix 5</u> Each group collected soil samples and measure physical parameters in the laboratory. Moreover, all groups measured noise levels at different locations using laboratory equipment that was bought under the URGENT project.



17 July 2022 - Sunday: Day 3 - In and out-class:

The lecture on water pollution was given by Dorjsuren Batsuren and after that, fieldwork to collect water samples and in-situ measurement was organized by two teaching staff jointly along the Tuul River.







18 July 2022 - Monday: Day 4 - In-class:

The lectures about sustainability indicators and ecosystem service-disservice were given by Anton Shkaruba and Anna Skryhan, respectively. After lectures, team works were organized. To fully understand the lectures in English, a translator was hired to translate all lectures into Mongolian.



19 July 2022 – Tuesday: Day 5 – In and out-class:

On the 5th day of summer school, we moved to the partner university, the Mongolian University of Life Sciences, and two lectures on urban green space planning and urban forest and its related seminar and laboratory works were organized.



20 July 2022 – Wednesday: Day 6 – Out-class:

On the 6th day of summer school, the partner university organized an excursion to Bogd Khaan mountain and hiking in the peri-urban forest. We traveled 45 km from the city and walked around 10 km to the top of the mountain.







21 July 2022 – Thursday: Day 7 – In and out-class:

On the 7th day of summer school, we moved to the partner institute, Urban planning and research institute, and National garden park. A lecture on sustainable and green urban planning was given at the UPRI. After the lecture, a study excursion to see the best example of the nature-based solution in Ulaanbaatar city, Misheel botanical garden organized (<u>https://www.facebook.com/Misheelbotanicalgarden</u>), and participants visited and understood what is the NbS. After lunch, the summer school continued at National Garden Park, which is the biggest green-blue park in the city to protect water resources.



22 July 2022 - Friday: Day 8 - In-class:

On the 8th day of summer school, we came back to the National University of Mongolia. Two lectures on Accessibility to urban ecosystems services and functions in contemporary cities and A stepwise approach for integrating nature conservation efforts into development planning were given by European teaching staff in-person and online, respectively. After lectures, the team works on the lecture topics were organized.







23 July 2022 - Saturday: Day 9 - In-class:

A lecture on Ecology, water, and the city was taught by Daniele La Rosa and after the lecture, a seminar on Planning criteria for sustainable urban drainage systems was discussed among participants. In the afternoon, a lecture on EU sustainable development policies and environmental innovation was given by N.Munkh, who is working at the Department of Europa study.



24 July 2022 - Sunday: Day 10 - In and out-class:

Two very interesting lectures on EU environmental innovation, its application in Mongolia, and Green finances and green bond standards were taught by the Mongolian Sustainable Finance Association, a partner of the ONE project. After lunch, participants visited the Plastic center and personally saw how plastic waste is recycled.



25 July 2022 - Monday: Day 11 - Out-class:

On the 11th day of summer school, we went to the Gorkhi-Terelj national park, which is located 80 km from the city. The stop was at the administration of the national park and a lecture on Special protected area management, and EU tools in Mongolia given by Namsrai Oyunchimeg. After the lecture, we went to the camping site to spend the next two days.



26 July 2022 – Tuesday: Day 12 – Out-class: On the 12th day, the summer school was continued at the national park, and case study-based nature protection management issues were taught.







27 July 2022 – Wednesday: Day 13 – Out-class:

On the 13th day, we came back to the city, and 5 study groups self-studied to discuss, wrap up, and prepared presentations on what they learned during summer school.



28 July 2022 – Thursday: Day 14 – In-class:

On the last day of summer school, the final lecture on Measuring progress: Indicators for sustainable development was given by Attila Katona. After the lecture, all 5 study groups were introduced to their presentations and explained what they get to know and how to apply their knowledge into practice. After lunch, successful participants handed over their certificates and expressed their impression of the summer school. In the evening, a farewell dinner was organized.


















Reporting

At the end of the summer school, an online feedback questionnaire has been developed and sent to all participants to ask how was the summer school. <u>Appendix 10</u>. English translation – <u>Appendix 11</u>. Based on the feedback questionnaire, the evaluation report of the summer school was written separately.





Conclusion

The joint summer school of the ONE and the URGENT projects, entitled "The settled nomadism-2022" was organized between 15 and 28 July 2022 for 14 days in Mongolia. During summer school, the participants acquired skills and knowledge about European Union environmental innovation (including management, policy, and financial instruments) and an understanding of the urban ecology environment, green-blue infrastructure, and nature-based solutions. There were 16 teaching staffs. Among them, 5 staffs came from European Universities. The summer school open call announced through the projects and the partners' websites and social media of the projects' partners in May 2022. No fee was required for participants. All costs, including teaching, out-city transportation, food, and accommodation during the out-of-city activity were supplied by the ONE project. The summer school was open to students at different levels (bachelor, master, Ph.D.), graduates, and lifelong learners. Online registration opened on 10 May and closed on 10 June 2022. In total, the summer school was live-streamed 10 times and viewed by 3055 audiences. At the end of the summer school, an online feedback questionnaire has been developed and sent to all participants to ask how was the summer school. Based on the participants' feedback, the following conclusion can be drawn.

- ~ Before to the summer school, the participants' knowledge related to the topics taught by the school was medium.
- Most of the participants got knowledge and skills that more than they expected. A quarter of participants expected that they can acquire more knowledge and skills if they involve.
- They acquired different types of useful knowledge and skills from this summer school, depending on their previous experience.
- Most interesting and practically applicable technology and knowledge from the EU were sustainable urban drainage systems and green and blue infrastructure.
- Most understandable topics were Special protected area management, EU tools in Mongolia, Urban green space planning, and Ecosystem service and disservice.
- \sim 92% of the participants evaluated that the study environment was very suitable.
- \sim Over 80% of the evaluation tells us that the field study was well organized.

Generally, summer school was excellently organized that approved by the feedback questionnaire.




